❑ Continuous Assessment

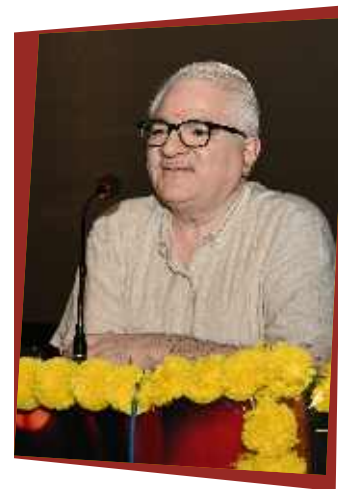

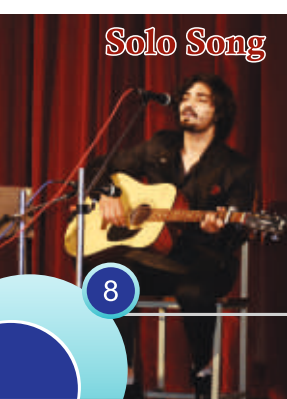

Admission Policy

Rules for Admission

- Confirmation of admission will be according to the rules of regulating bodies i.e. University of Rajasthan, Jaipur; Directorate of College Education, Jaipur; Directorate of Technical Education, Jodhpur and Rajasthan Technical University, Kota.
- At the time of admission the applicant has to submit the self attested photocopies along with the requisite original documents.
- Admission will be made on the basis of merit according to the availability of seats in the concerned programme.
- Fee must be deposited through Cheque / DD/ Bank Challan / NEFT in favour of Shri Mahaveer College.
- Admission will be provisional untill the applicant completes all admission related formalities.
- An applicant who is declared eligible to appear in the supplementary examination may be provisionally admitted

Code of Conduct

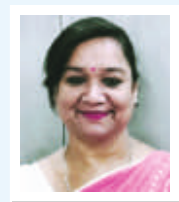

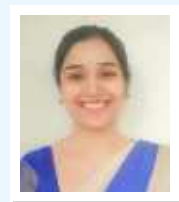

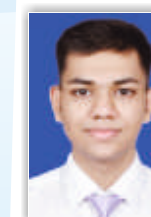
