Admission Policy

Rules for Admission

- Confirmation of admission will be according to the rules of regulating bodies i.e. University of Rajasthan, Jaipur; Directorate of College Education, Jaipur; Directorate of Technical Education, Jodhpur and Rajasthan Technical University, Kota.
- At the time of admission the applicant has to submit the self attested photocopies along with the requisite original documents.
- Admission will be made on the basis of merit according to the availability of seats in the concerned programme.
- Fee must be deposited through Cheque / DD/ Bank Challan / NEFT in favour of Shri Mahaveer College.
- Admission will be provisional until the applicant completes all admission related formalities.
- An applicant who is declared eligible to appear in the supplementary examination may be provisionally admitted.

Scholarship Schemes

Merit Scholarships:

- 25% for students scoring: More than 80% - RBSE
- More than 85% - CBSE & Other Boards
- More than 70% - University Examination (for PG Programmes)

Sports Scholarships:

- 50% for National Level Players
- 25% for State Level Players

Jain Community Scholarship:

- 25% in first year of all UG/PG Programmes

Girl Child Scholarship:

- 25% in all two/three/four years of UG/PG Programme

Alumni Scholarship (MPS/SMDJ/SMC):

- 25% in all two/three/four years of UG/PG Programme

Defence and Martyr's Ward Scholarship:

- 100% relaxation to Martyr's ward in tuition fee for all two/three/four years of UG/PG Programme
- 25% to Soldier's ward in all two/three/four years of UG/PG Programme

*Policies are subject to revision as per management decision and only one scholarship can be availed by the student at a time.

Code of Conduct

- ❑ Every student must carry his/her identity card in person whenever he/she is in the college premises, and present it for inspection on demand.
- ❑ Students must not loiter in the college premises while the classes are going on.
- ❑ Smoking and consumption of tobacco/alcohol in the college premises or entering the college premises, after consuming alcoholic drinks is strictly prohibited.
- ❑ Disciplinary action will be taken against students found using cell phones, iPods etc. during the classes.
- ❑ Students are expected to take proper care of college property and help the college authorities in keeping the premises clean. Damaging college property e.g. disfiguring walls, doors fittings or breaking furniture, misuse of fittings, misuse of A.C. etc., is breach of discipline, and the guilty will be duly punished.
- ❑ Hacking in computer system, manipulation or damage of computers and software or any other cyber crime etc. is strictly prohibited.
- ❑ For an offence committed in (i) Institution (ii) in the classroom, the Principal shall have the authority to impose fine or any other punishment.
- ❑ Insubordination and abusive language or misconduct on the part of a student is sufficient reason for his/her suspension or dismissal.
- ❑ No Society or Association shall be formed in the college and no person will be invited to address a meeting without the Principal's prior permission.
- ❑ All college activities are organized under the guidance and supervision of the Principal and Faculty In-charge.
